REPUBLICANS	
<b>MITT ROMNEY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vetoed legislation to reimburse Medicare providers for cost of providing kosher meals to the elderly.</li> <li>• Despite Serving as a Bishop in the Church of Latter Day Saints (LDS), Romney is the only LDS elected official not to speak out against posthumous baptisms of Holocaust victims.</li> <li>• Romney kicked off campaign a the Ford Museum in Michigan, named after leading anti-Semitic businessman and Nazi-supporter Henry Ford.</li> </ul>
<b>RUDY GIULIANI</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Owned lobbying firm that represented Saudi Arabian, Venezuela (CITGO) oil interests and chewing tobacco industry.</li> <li>• Foreign Policy Team headed by Neo-Conservatives, Pipes, Podhertz, who pushed U.S. into Iraq.</li> </ul>
<b>FRED THOMPSON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Campaign Chairman is anti-Israel former Senator Spencer Abraham (R-MI)</li> </ul>
<b>JOHN McCAIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Said he would send Bush Secretary of State James Baker to mediate between Israel and Palestinians.</li> <li>• Foreign Policy Team headed by James Baker ally Adm. Brent Scowcroft.</li> <li>• Told Beliefnet that America is a “Christian Nation”</li> </ul>
<b>MIKE HUCKABEE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Joked that he lost weight because “Democrats put him in a Concentration Camp”</li> <li>• Went on record as not believing in evolution and has called for the nation to be taken back in Christ.</li> <li>• Campaign Chairman Ed Rollins was accused of paying African-American ministers in New Jersey to discourage turnout.</li> </ul>
<b>DUNCAN HUNTER</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sponsored legislation to force sectarian Christian prayer at mandatory-attendance military events</li> <li>• Only candidate to oppose any peace process in the Middle East</li> </ul>
<b>RON PAUL</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “Dr. No” has opposed every pro-Israel legislation proposed in the Congress.</li> <li>• Opposes immunization programs for children.</li> </ul>
